1. Having Suffered The Passion



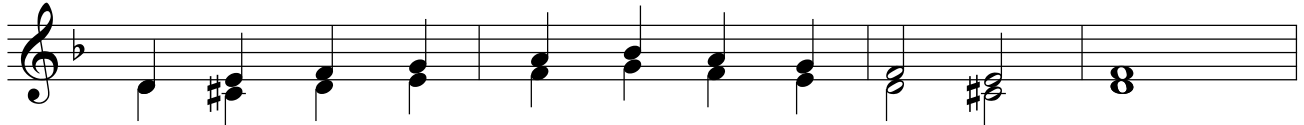
Hav - ing suf - fered the Pas - sion for us, Je - sus Christ, Son of God,
