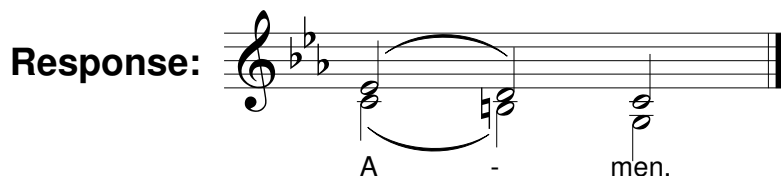


The Panachida (Memorial Service)

O Holy One, come to us and heal our infirmities for Your Name's sake.

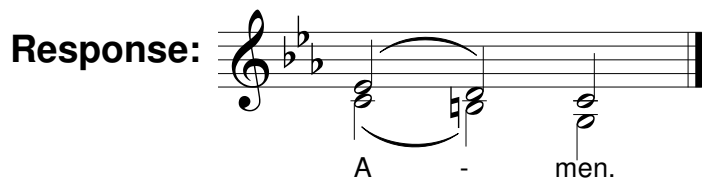
Priest: Lord, have mercy (3 times).

Response: Lord, _____ have mer - cy.


